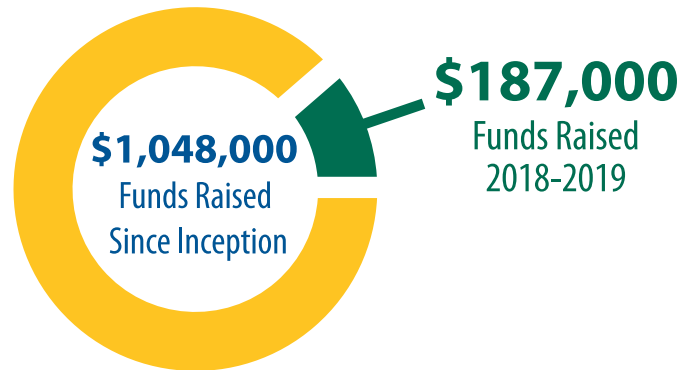


We are committed to preparing students to be life-long learners and honorable leaders of tomorrow.

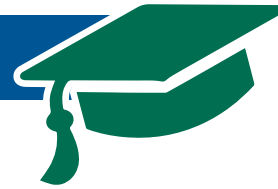


Safety Enhancements

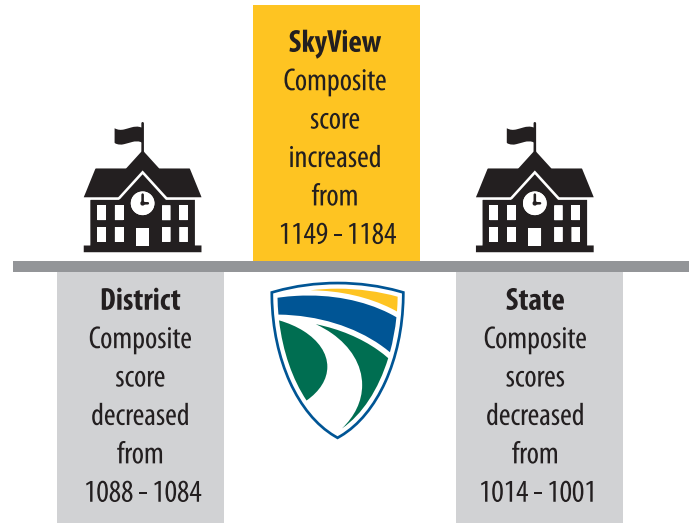
Academic Achievements



- **86% of SVA graduates are college-bound (compared to 58.2% CO average)**
- **Won the state title twice for the Big Idea Project**
- **Daniel's Fund Scholarship winner**

- **Our Destination Imagination (DI) middle school and elementary school teams have gone to Globals repeatedly**
- **We have inducted over 200 students into our chapter of the National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) in the past four years**
- **Our students in all grades have done countless hours of service work with numerous organizations such as Colorado Young Leaders and the Douglas County Task Force and Food Bank**
- **Our middle school students raised enough money to provide food, shelter, and education to Haitian orphans through Hawks for Haiti, and provided thanksgiving meals and black socks to Fort Carson soldiers coming home from deployment for the holidays before re-deploying**
- **Our elementary school students have raised over \$20,000 to fund life-saving research to prevent heart disease through Jump Rope for Heart, and SVA came together to raise approximately \$10,000 in our first ever Wish Week last year**
